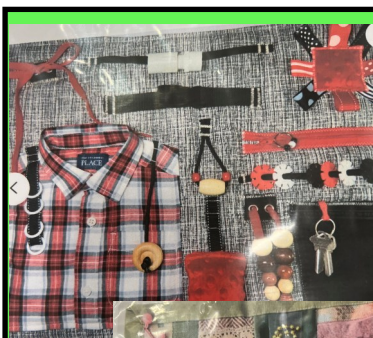
Charity Quilt Sew Day: April 1st (NO FOOLING!) 9:30—3:00

Susan Lucas & Barb McGovern have been working hard to make this day fun & productive as we create quilts and pillowcases to give to those in need.

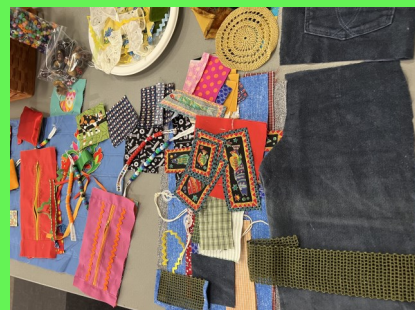
