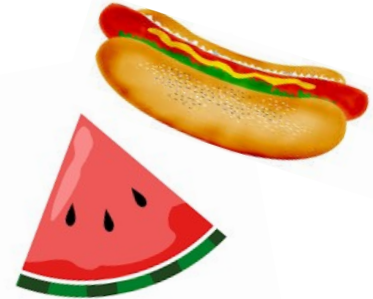

## Brenda Richard's Potluck Hot Brown

6 slices of bread, toasted  
1/2 pound sliced turkey  
1/2 pound sliced ham  
6 pieces of bacon, cooked  
1 cup shredded cheddar cheese

### WHITE SAUCE

1 tbsp butter  
1 tbsp all purpose flour  
1/4 tsp salt  
1/4 tsp white pepper  
1 1/2 cups of milk

To make 1 1/2 cup thin sauce melt butter in saucepan over low heat. Blend in flour, salt and pepper. Increase heat to medium. Add milk all at once. Stir constantly till mixture bubbles and thickens.

Cut bread, turkey and ham in serving size pieces. Put bread on bottom of 9 X 13 pan then add ham and turkey. Pour sauce over and spread evenly. Crumble bacon into bite size pieces and lay on top of sauce. Sprinkle with cheese. Bake at 350 for about 20 minutes till bubbly around the edges.

This can be modified to suit you. And it freezes well.
