



# Quilter's Yard Sale

April 13th, 8-1:00 p.m.



The Quilt Guild will be hosting a quilting-related yard sale on Saturday, April 13th. Set up will be Friday evening, the 12th. Members can "rent" a table for \$25, refundable when they participate on the day of the sale. Non-members will pay a \$25 table rental fee.

- You can share a table with another individual, as long as the items are all Quilt or sewing related and in good condition.
- You will be responsible for your own sales: there will be no central checkout.

#### If you are participating, be sure to bring:

- SIGN that states the methods of payment accepted (cash, Zelle, Check, venmo, etc)
- Change & plastic bags. After a sale is complete we ask that you tie the bag shut to discourage sticky fingers.
- All fabric must be measured & priced. (a box of like items can have a single sign).

Set up & guild member shopping will be Friday night, times TBD. We will advertise at QDO, local guilds and quilt shops so we should have a great turnout!

# STASHBUSTER CHALLENGE

If you signed up to participate in the 2023 Stashbuster Challenge, bring your quilt or quilt tops to the meeting on the 9th. Prizes will be drawn based on the members who completed blocks in each category:

1. 52 week/ 52 block challenge: all who completed will receive a small prize. Drawing for 2 winners of 60 x 60" batting.
2. 26 week/26 block challenge: Drawing for 2 winners of 60 x 60" backing fabric.
3. 12 month/12 block challenge: Drawing for 2 quilt shop gift cards.
