



We are excited that Fran O'Connor has stepped up to chair this committee in the future.

A Note from Fran:

Many thanks to those who brought quilts (8!!!) to the last meeting for distribution to some of the charities with which we work. These charities include Eastern State Hospital, the Methodist Children's Home & the Nest.

For those who may not know, the Guild provides batting & backing for charity quilts. We also have donated fabric which is available, most of which has been cut into 2.5" strips. Patterns are also available. Please contact Fran at fsoofssi@gmail.com if you need these items.

If you are a long-arm quilter and are able to provide quilting services, please contact Fran. Batting & backing will be provided. The person who pieced the top would sew on the binding and label to finish the quilt.

The charities have requested baby 30" x 40", throw: 50" x 65" and twin-sized quilts: 70" x 90". The Methodist Children's Home has especially requested quilts for male teens as these seem to be in short supply.
