


Community Outreach

For August's Block Lotto we will be celebrating the return to school with a Colored Pencils block!

There are 18 background fabric blocks with the pattern available for \$1 each..

The block is based on the Dresden Plate block and directions come with a template to use while making the block. Lissa will also be offering a small "how to" hour at 2pm on Saturday during the sit and sew. Participants should bring their blocks and sew along!

Want to learn how to make the Dresden block, but couldn't snag a Lotto bag? The pattern and template will be available for 50 cents, no fabric included. Please bring a 12 1/2" square and four fat eighths (9" x 22") to the demonstration (three colors for the pencil lead and barrel, one for the wood).


